

Dear League Teams,

Wilmot Recreational Centre has the below COVID-19 protocols in place for anyone entering the facility. Please notify all your team members, parents, spectators, and volunteers that will be visiting the facility to play games against New Hamburg (NHHA) teams.

Face coverings are required for anyone entering the building as per the Waterloo Region bylaw. All bench staff members are to keep their face coverings during games while on the bench. Players may remove their face covering when putting on their helmet to step on the ice and must re-apply their face covering after exiting the ice.

Visiting bench staff and players are to confirm at the front door they have completed their own team pre-screening (bench staff, parents, siblings, spectators and players). Visiting Head Coaches will be contacted for these records by Public Health if required.

Parents, siblings and spectators can also pre-screen before they arrive to the arena and take a screenshot on their phone to show the Security Guard at the door their screening was completed.

Facility Security will be checking everyone's ID and proof of vaccination at the door. Note:

- Players 12 to 18 years old playing in the game on the ice and patrons (spectators, siblings) under 12 years old will be required to show ID but do not require proof of vaccination.
- U18 2004 born players who turn 18 will be required to show proof of vaccination after their 2022 birthday.
- Spectators 12 and older are required to show ID and proof of vaccination (with date administered) at the door.
- Medical exemptions from a doctor or practitioner can be provided.
- Violence and harassment are prohibited with possible Police contact for non-compliance.

Please ensure everyone respects the rules. To summarize for reference:

1. Stay at home if you're not feeling well or fail your pre-screening.
2. Pre-screen before arriving and show proof at the door.
3. Wear a face covering (as per Waterloo Region bylaw) unless engaged in sport.
4. Players inform Security at the door they did their pre-screening and gave to their coach.
5. Visiting Head Coach keeps player screening records.
6. Show ID and full vaccine receipt at the door. (age 12+, players exempted if playing).
7. Dressing room access is 15 minutes prior and 15 minutes after ice times with no showers.
8. Players should come pre-dressed as much as possible with no indoor warm-ups allowed.
9. Practice physical distancing (2 meters) and follow dressing room capacity limit of 15. Use benches outside dressing rooms for extra players and coaching staff.
10. Use proper hygiene and wash hands frequently.
