

PARTICIPANT FEELS ILL AT THE FACILITY/ACTIVITY



Participant advises Head Coach/team staff immediately



Participant receives a cloth mask/face covering and wears immediately. Anyone caring for the participant should also wear a cloth mask/face covering



Parents/guardians are advised and take the participant home and remove the participant from the facility.



Parents/guardians are required to phone Waterloo Region Public Health **519-575-4400** and follow direction/isolation guidelines from Public Health. Parents/guardians are advised to inform the head coach of what these guidelines are once Public Health has been contacted



The participant will be required to follow the direction of PH or physician AND be symptom free for 24 hours prior to return to play. **Any member of the household who is involved in the New Hamburg Huskies Association can continue to attend practice/play if they are not experiencing any symptoms, if they develop symptoms they must not attend practice/play and contact PH for direction prior to returning to practice/play.**

This will be communicated to the Head Coach prior to return to play

Head Coach will email the Head Trainer at nhhaheadtrainer@gmail.com with the players name who has become ill.

PARTICIPANT FAILS SCREENING PRIOR TO PRACTICE/PLAY



Head Coach/team staff are immediately notified via automatic email app of participants failed screening. Participant does not attend practice/play



Parents/guardians are required to phone Waterloo Region Public Health **519-575-4400** and follow direction/isolation guidelines from Public Health. Parents/guardians are advised to inform the head coach of what these guidelines are once Public Health has been contacted



The participant will be required to follow the direction of PH or physician AND be symptom free for 24 hours prior to return to play. **Any member of the household who is involved in the New Hamburg Huskies Association can continue to attend practice/play if they are not experiencing any symptoms, if they develop symptoms they must not attend practice/play and contact PH for direction prior to returning to practice/play.**

PARTICIPANT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19



Participant advises head coach/team staff immediately via email. Participant does not attend practice/play



Parents/guardians are advised to phone Waterloo Region Public Health **519-575-4400** and follow direction/isolation guidelines from Public Health. Parents/guardians are advised to inform the head coach of what these guidelines are once Public Health has been contacted



The participant will require a NEGATIVE COVID-19 swab test and be symptom free for 24 hrs prior to return to practice/play. The participant will be required to remain absent from practice/play for 14 days following onset of symptoms. **The participant and any member of the household who is involved in the New Hamburg Huskies Association will require Public Health or physician authorization to return to play on their team.**

This will be communicated to the Head Coach and the Head Trainer prior to return to play
